# **Governor Update**

You may have seen recent news regarding national school funding. There has been a re-model of schools budgets for 2017/18 onwards, and whilst this has a national tag line of "fairer funding" a number of schools see budget squeezes rather than gains.

Ashby Willesley does unfortunately see a small reduction in funding, however with a healthy balance sheet and a revised budget (including projections into 2018/19) the school will meet this squeeze with minimal impact to the children. We will of course be keeping a close eye on school finances and any further national challenges thrown our way.

The mix of activities taking place in school is truly excellent, (to name a few) a number of us saw muddy kids return from a day of cross country, whilst others participate in swimming galas, choir performances or stay away on residential visits all in conjunction with the focus on learning and individual progression; even some mock SATS for year 6 have taken place. We see this as a really healthy balance of learning and extra-curricular accomplishments – well done all!


